Emergency Food also available during normal business hours from the Church Office Monday – Friday

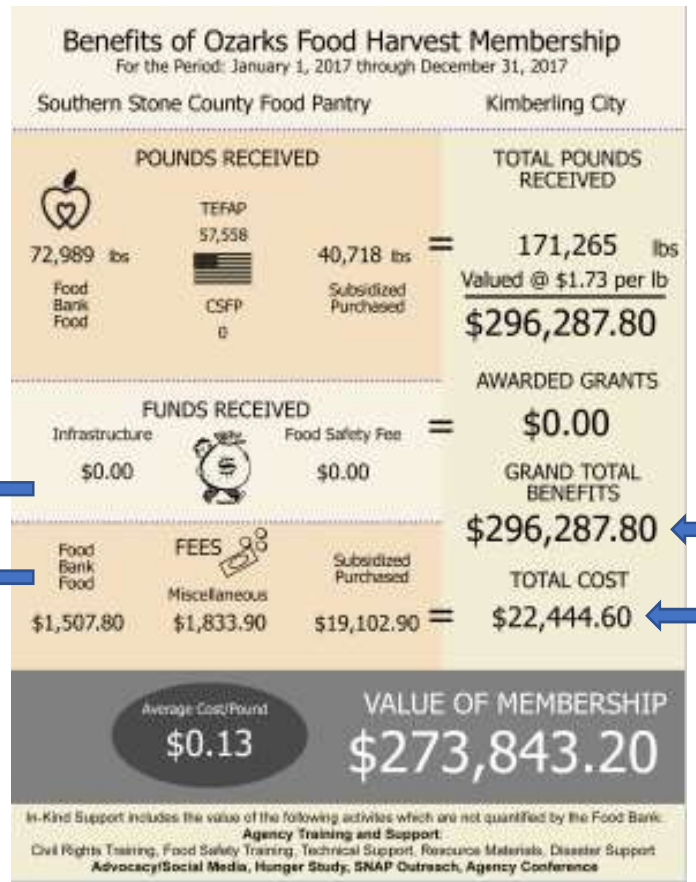

The SSCFP receives most of the food from the Federal government, donated food and food at reduced prices distributed by Ozark Food Harvest (see charts below), as well as significant donations from the local Walmart. Additionally, food is purchased at a reduced price from local grocers.
